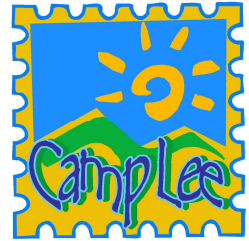


What to Bring to Camp Lee

PLEASE LABEL ALL BELONGINGS WITH PERMANENT MARKER



1. Your Bible
2. A good attitude - friendly to all; attentive; helpful; positive
3. (1) Beach Towel *for swimming.*
4. (2) Towels and washcloths *for everyday use.*
5. Sheets/blanket & pillow for TWIN BED **OR** a sleeping bag and pillow.
6. Bathing Suit: girls—*modest*; boys—*no cut-offs*
7. Comfortable sportswear/playclothes for hot weather—*enough for entire week; EXTRAS to get wet and dirty.*
8. One LONG pair of pants and a jacket for cool evenings.
9. Shoes that will stay on your feet - no crocs or flip flops.
Tennis shoes and socks for hiking and active play.
Shoes that can get wet for rockslide, creek and zipline.
10. Personal toiletries—*soap, toothbrush & toothpaste, shampoo & tissues, etc.*
11. Label all medications with child's name place in Ziploc bag with written instructions for dispensing.
12. Flashlight with working batteries.
13. Sunscreen and bug repellent.
14. Raincoat/rainwear.
15. Large plastic garbage bag for dirty clothes with name on outside.

Optional items: camera and film; fishing equipment.

- **Money**
- **Food** - snacks are provided. Food not allowed in cabins.
- **Pop Idol or Teen magazines/games/cards** - all activities are provided.
- **Personal Electronic Equipment or Telephones**—our goal is to connect with each other.
