

Interested in belonging to First Baptist?

When you're ready to make a decision about membership, there are two things you need to do:

- come forward during the last song in the service. The Pastor will be there to welcome you, then he will introduce you to the congregation.
- attend Discovery Class. Attendance at Discovery Class is a requirement for membership. Discovery Class is a one-session two-hour class offered once a month and led by the Pastor (for youth and adults) and Minister to Children (for school-age children). You may attend after deciding to join and coming forward, or before as part of your decision-making process.

Listed below are the different ways we receive new members. Any of our deacons or ministers can explain them more fully.

- **By Profession of Faith and Baptism.** If you will receive Jesus Christ as your personal Savior and Lord and follow Him in baptism by immersion, "believer's baptism," we will joyfully receive you into our family.
- **By Letter.** If you have already accepted Jesus Christ as your personal Savior and Lord and have experienced believer's baptism in another church, we joyfully receive you into our family. We will gladly take care of the details of transferring your membership.
- **By Baptism from Another Denomination.** If you know that you are saved and have been a member of a church in another denomination, but have not experienced believer's baptism, we invite you to join our family by baptism. This gives testimony of your salvation and obedience to Christ's example.
- **By Statement.** If you have accepted Jesus Christ as your personal Savior and Lord, have experienced believer's baptism, and are a member of another church, but your church membership records are not available, we joyfully receive you into our family upon your statement of your salvation.
